

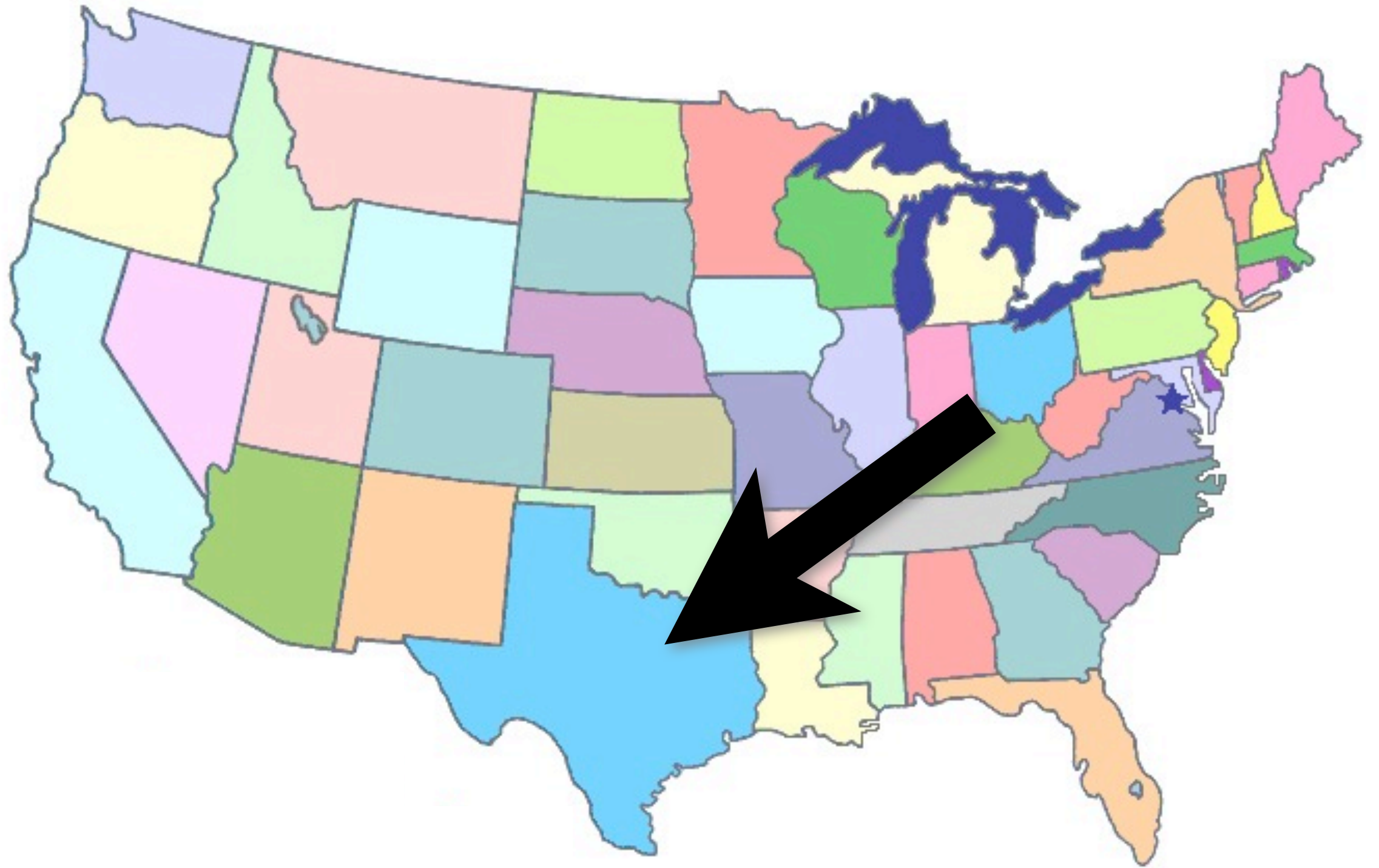

► Fix Broken Windows



Broken Windows Theory

- Fix small problems (a broken window in a building)
- Stops larger problems developing

Broken Windows Theory

- Applied in New York City

Broken Windows Theory

- Applied in New York City
- Between 1993 and 1997:
 - serious crimes dropped **44%**
 - robberies dropped **50%**
 - murders dropped **60%**

Broken Windows Theory

- Stop “code rot” and “process rot”
- Fix problems as soon as they occur.
 - Fix little problems == fewer big problems

The DRY Principle

Don't **R**epeat **Y**ourself:

*“Every piece of knowledge
must have a single,
unambiguous, authoritative
representation within a system”*



Code Duplication

- Fix with methods, modules, classes...
- Fix with code generators
- Fix with metaprogramming



Design Duplication

- Fix with patterns
- Fix with conventions
- Fix with metaphors



Architecture Duplication

- Fix with frameworks
- Fix with service-based architectures



Project Duplication

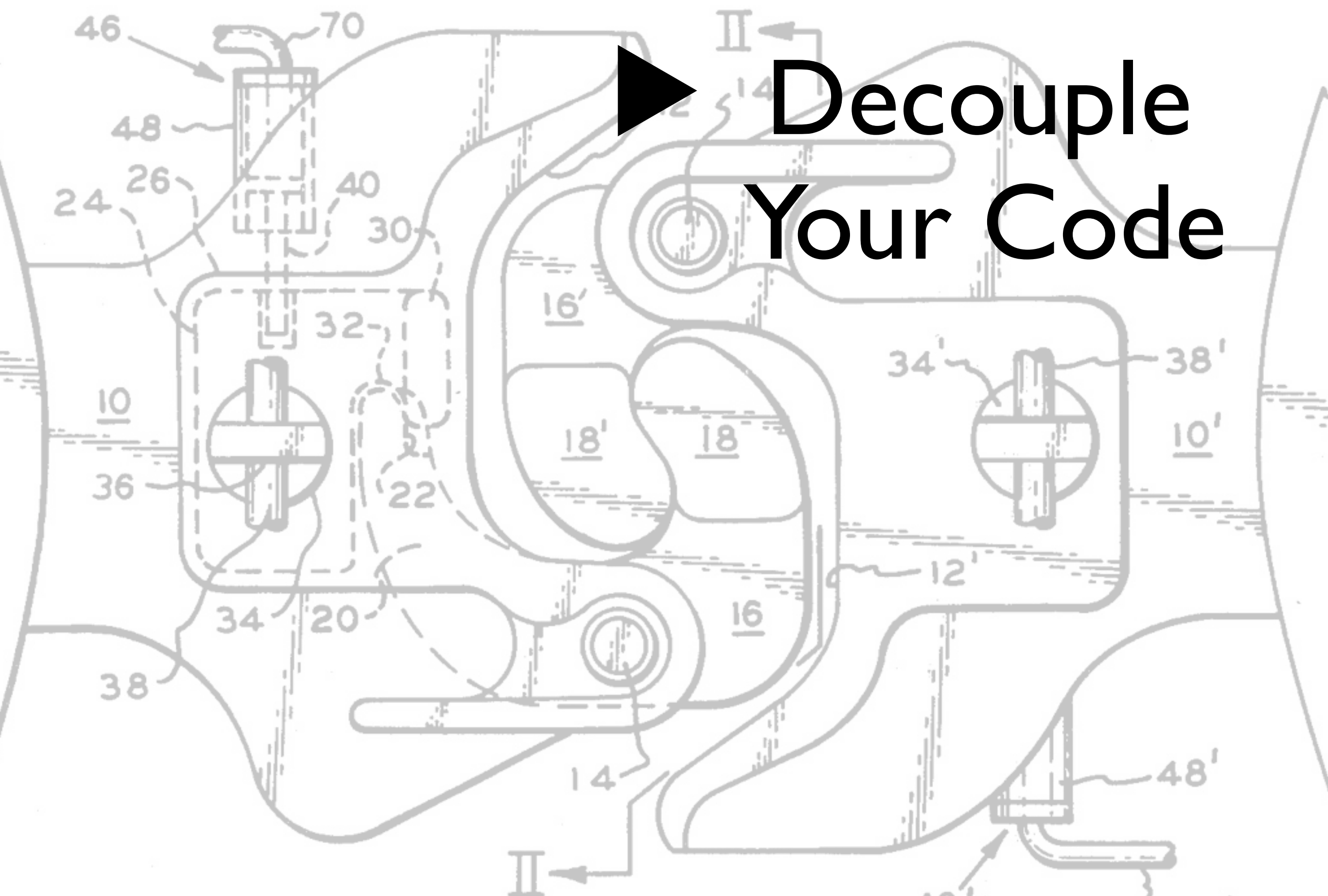
- Fix by producing products
- Fix with data-driven designs



Duplication Inhibits Change

- One business decision—multiple changes
- potentially at many levels
- Maintenance becomes difficult
- easy to forget to change something

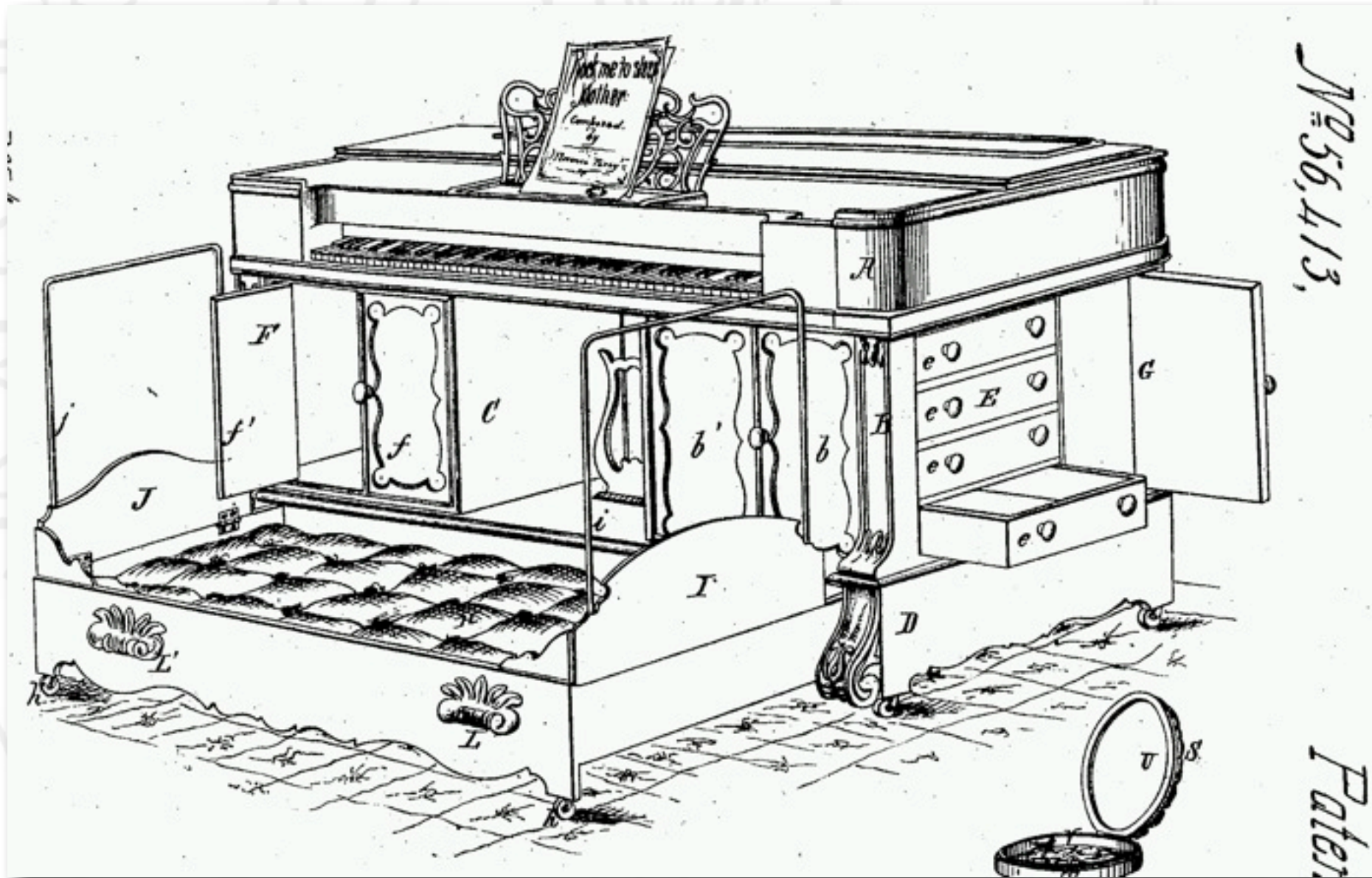
Decouple Your Code



Keep Things Unrelated

- Why?
 - Easier to write
 - Easier to understand
 - Easier to change
- Techniques
 - increase cohesion
 - reduce coupling

Cohesion: Do One Thing Well...



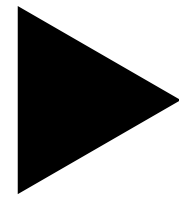

Reduce Coupling

- Overly-coupled code is:
 - Hard to understand
 - Hard to maintain
 - Difficult to reuse

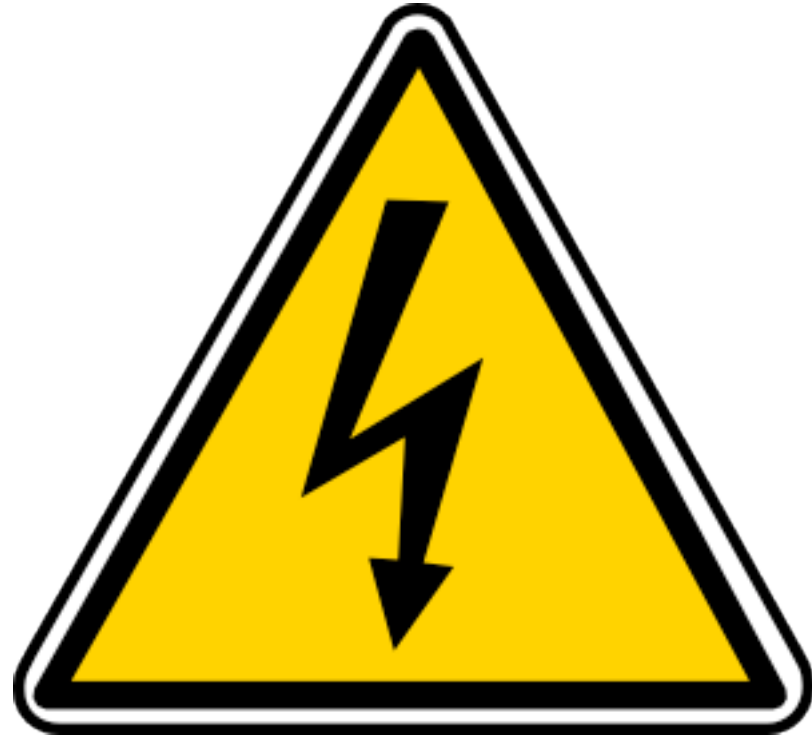
