

- Starting to see more parallelism




But The Basic Are Ideas are Still the Same

Don't Repeat Yourself:

"Every piece of knowledge must have a single, unambiguous, authoritative representation within a system"

Code Duplication

- Fix with methods, modules, classes...
- Fix with code generators
- Fix with metaprogramming

Design Duplication



- Fix with conventions
- Fix with metaphors

Architecture Duplication

Fix with frameworks


• Fix with servicebased architectures

Project Duplication




• Fix with data-driven designs

Duplication Inhibits Change



- One business decision multiple changes
 - potentially at many levels
- Maintenance becomes difficult
 - easy to forget to change something




Keep Things Unrelated

- Why?
 - Easier to write
 - Easier to understand
 - Easier to change
- Techniques
 - increase cohesion
 - reduce coupling

Reduce Coupling

 - Hard to maintain
 - Difficult to reuse








Pragmatic Agile
